Construction of the I-205 MAX Light Rail Project will interrupt bicycle traffic on the current I-205 multi-use path. So on July 13, TriMet and its project partners will unveil a new 6.5-mile alternate bike route. Because riders of all kinds will be using the new route, we see this as a double opportunity: **1) Show riders the route; 2) Celebrate local biking culture.** We're inviting advocacy groups, related agencies and every kind of riding group to set up booths, and we're looking to draw hundreds of riders to check out the new route.
